Deacon-Led Ministry Teams

The King's Buddies:

This team will minister to people with physical or mental challenges or disabilities, relating the gospel on a level that they understand. We will provide a Sunday School setting or class which is age, ability or comprehension appropriate for its members. We will provide family members the opportunity to participate in Bible study or worship service while their children are cared for.

The King's Transporters:

This team will minister to persons who cannot provide their own transportation to and from KGBC services and special events, including getting to crucial appointments such as medical or dental, etc.

The King's Uplifters:

This team will seek to support, visit and pray for families in need. They will encourage people by finding out what various families need and share with other deacon teams to help meet those needs, interceding through prayer and sending cards as needed.

The King's Community:

This is an outreach team to identify needs in our community, promote the church and its activities in our community, invite church members to participate in community programs, and

to work with other churches and community organizations in ecumenical ministries such as the winter shelter and the Judeo-Christian Outreach Center.

The King's Advocates:

This team exists as a ministry to widows, single parents and military families, to be an information source, advocate, and to link these groups to other ministry teams that could meet needs.

The King's Missionaries:

To help KGBC be on mission with God through various projects throughout the year, locally and around our country and the world.

The King's Contactors:

This is our visitor follow up and community outreach team, contacting first-time guests who attend our worship and/or Sunday School, and maintaining an outreach emphasis to new residents of our community.

The King's Cooks:

This team will provide meals to church families who are in need due to crisis or an urgent schedule change. This ministry would allow recipients to be able to address their family's needs rather than worry about shopping and cooking. Meals can be provided frozen, cooked or purchased. Meals shall be provided complete with beverage, paper products, plastic ware, etc.

The King's Carpenters:

This is our small jobs team. We want to help those who need help with small projects but are unable to provide for themselves. We will work in homes or on autos, providing for their safety and well being.

The King's Consolers:

We seek to help persons affected by the death of a loved one. This is a ministry of visitation to the home, funeral home, funeral service, as well as providing some care items in this time of need.

The King's Connectors:

The goal of this team is to assist people to move into different levels of involvement and commitment in church life; connecting people to teams, ministries and classes.

We are all members of one body, and have a specific function to perform for the good of the community! Join us in serving God and others.
